



Knitting Pattern for
two pram sets for 7-
12" baby boy doll

Boy's pram sets 7-12" doll

Materials (for either suit)

7-8" Doll

Approx 40g of 3 ply yarn (US: fingering)

Needles: One pair of 2 ¼ mm(UK 13)(US 1)

9-10" Doll

Approx 65g of 4 ply yarn (US: sport)

Needles: One pair of 3 ¼ mm(UK 10)(US 3) and one pair of 2 ¾ mm(UK 12)(US 2)

11-12" Doll

Approx 85g of DK yarn (US: light worsted)

Needles: One pair of 3 ¼ mm(UK10) (US 3)and one pair of 4 mm(UK 8) (US 6)

All three sizes

3 small buttons

Shirring elastic

Small length of 3mm ribbon for boot bows – approx 0.5m (for one suit)

Embellishments

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Abbreviations

K: knit

P: purl

G-st: garter stitch

St-st: Stocking stitch

Dec: decrease

Inc: increase by knitting into front and back of stitch

Sl 1: slip next stitch

Pss: Pass slipped stitch(es) over

C2B: Knit into back of 2nd st on needle, then K 1st st, slipping both sts off needle at same time.

Yb: Put yarn to back of work when changing from P to K

Yf: Put yarn to front of work when changing from K to P

K2togtbl: knit 2 tog through back of stitches

Sl2 tog: Slip next 2 stitches onto right hand

M1: Make 1 stitch by inserting lh needle into yarn between last and current st, slipping onto lh needle and knitting into the back of.

Tension (in st-st)

3-ply: 32 stitches and 40 rows to 10 cm. (4 inches) on a 3 ¼ mm (US 3) needle.

4-ply: 28 stitches and 36 rows to 10 cm. (4 inches) on a 3 ¼ mm (US 3)needle.

Double knitting: 22 stitches and 30 rows to 10 cm. (4 inches) on a 4 mm (US 6) needle.

The pattern is written using the terms 'larger' and 'smaller' needles. If you are knitting for a 10-12" doll use DK yarn and 4mm (larger) and 3¼ mm (smaller) needles as listed in materials. For the 8-9" doll use 4-ply yarn and 3 ¼ mm (larger)and 2 ¾ mm (smaller) needles. For the 6-7" doll use 3-ply yarn and 2 ¼ mm needles throughout (no larger or smaller)

needle together, K4, rep from * to end

Working in st-st cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows. (25sts)
Cont in st-st for a further 14 rows.

Pram Suit with Cabled Coat

Coat

Back

Using larger needles cast on 44sts.

Patt as follows:

1st row: P4, *yb, Sl 2 purlways, C2B, P4, rep from * to end

2nd row: K4, *yf, Sl 2 purlways, purl the 2nd st on lh needle, then the 1st st, slipping both sts from

3rd row: K

4th row: P

Work a further 23 rows in patt

Decrease

P2tog, *P1, P2tog, rep from * to end (29sts)

Shape armholes

Shape shoulders

Cast off 8, K8, cast off 8. Leave rem centre 9sts on holder.

Left front

Using larger needles cast on 20sts.
Work 27 rows in patt as for back
Decrease
*P2tog, P2, rep from * to end
(15sts)

Shape armholes

Working in st-st cast off 2 sts at beg of next row. (13sts)
Cont in st-st for a further 8 rows.

Shape neck

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next row.
Dec 1 st at neck edge of next 3 rows (8sts)
Work 3 further rows in st-st. Cast off.

Right front

Using larger needles cast on 20sts.
Work 27 rows in patt as for back
Decrease
*P2tog, P2, rep from * to end
(15sts)
K 1 row.

Shape armholes

Working in st-st cast off 2 sts at beg of next row. (13sts)
Cont in st-st for a further 8 rows.

Shape neck

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next row.
Dec 1 st at neck edge of next 3 rows (8sts)
Work 2 further rows in st-st. Cast off.

Sleeves

Using larger needles cast on 28sts.
Work 28 rows in patt as for back.
Cast off.

Neckband

Join shoulder seams. Using smaller needles pick up and K 10 sts up right front, K across 9sts of back and pick up and K 10 sts down left front. Work 3 rows in g-st. cast off.

Buttonband

Using smaller needles pick up and K 34 sts evenly along left front

edge from top of neckband to bottom of front. Work 3 rows in g-st. Cast off

Buttonhole band

Using smaller needles pick up and K 34 sts evenly along right front edge bottom of front to top of neckband. Work 3 rows in g-st working button holes as follows on 2nd row: K22, (yfwd, K2tog, K3) twice, yfwd, K2tog. Cast off.

Making up

Sew sleeves into place. Join sleeve and side seams. Sew buttons onto buttonband to correspond to holes in buttonhole band. Add any desired embellishments – I added a teddy to each chest front.

Trousers

Right leg

Using larger needles cast on 20 sts and work 3 rows in g-st.

Increase

K2, *inc in next st, rep from * to last 2 sts, K2 (36sts)

Cont in patt as follows:

1st row: *K3, P3, rep from * to end

2nd and alt rows: P

3rd row: P1, *K3, P3 rep from * to last 5 sts, K3, P2

5th row: P2, *K3, P3, rep from * to last 4 sts, K3, P1

7th row: *P3, K3, rep from * to end

9th row: P2, *K3, P3, rep from * to last 4 sts, K3, P1

11th row: P1, *K3, P3 rep from * to last 5 sts, K3, P2

12th (alt) row: P

Repeat these 12 rows once more.

****You may wish to work extra rows here, especially for larger dolls in DK. Check your leg length and work further rows in pattern if required. End with a ws row and continue as follows****

Break yarn. Leave sts on holder or safety pin. Place marker at outside edge of last row.

Left leg

Using larger needles cast on 20 sts and work 3 rows in g-st.

Increase

K2, *inc in next st, rep from * to last 2 sts, K2 (36sts)

Cont in patt as follows:

1st row: *K3, P3, rep from * to end

2nd and alt rows: P

3rd row: P1, *K3, P3 rep from * to last 5 sts, K3, P2

5th row: P2, *K3, P3, rep from * to last 4 sts, K3, P1

7th row: *P3, K3, rep from * to end

9th row: P2, *K3, P3, rep from * to last 4 sts, K3, P1

11th row: P1, *K3, P3 rep from * to last 5 sts, K3, P2

12th (alt) row: P

Repeat these 12 rows once more.

****Work same number of rows as right leg****

Do not break yarn. Place marker at outside edge of last row.

Body

Continuing in pattern on left leg, patt across 36 sts of left leg, patt across 36 sts of right leg. (72 sts)

Work in patt for 18 rows.

Decrease

*P1, P2tog rep from * to end (48sts)

Change to smaller needles and work 4 rows of K1, P1 rib. Cast off in rib.

Making up

Join back seam of body from rib to crotch and markers. Sew leg seams to bottom. Using shirring elastic thread through waistband to elasticate as desired.

Shoes

Using larger needles cast on 15 sts. K2 rows. Work 2 rows in st-st starting with a K row.

Shape instep

Next row: K 9, turn
Next row: P 3 turn
Work 4 rows in st-st on these 3 sts.
Break yarn.

Cont from 6 sts on rh needle and pick up and K 3 sts along side of instep, across 3 sts of instep, pick up and K 3 sts down other side of instep and across rem 6 sts. (21sts)
Next row: P8, inc in next st, P3, inc in next st, P to end. (23sts)

Work 5 rows in st-st. K 1 row.

Shape sole

1st row: K 3, *K2tog, K2 rep from * to end (18sts)

2nd row: K2tog, K5, K2tog twice, K5, K2tog (14sts)

3rd row: K

Cast off.

Making up

Sew sole seam and back seam to complete shoe. Add ribbon bow to front of shoe if desired.

Hat

Using smaller needles cast on 44sts and work 13 rows in 1x1 rib. Change to larger needles and cont in main patt as for coat back for 12 rows.

Decrease

1st row: K1, *K2tog, K4 rep from * to last st, K1 (37sts)

2nd and alt rows: P

3rd row: K1, *K2tog, K3, rep from * to last st, K1 (30sts)

5th row: K1, *K2tog, K2, rep from * to last st, K1 (23sts)

7th row: K1, *K2tog, K1, rep from * to last st, K1 (16sts)

8th row(alt): *P2tog, rep from * to end (8sts)

Cut yarn, leaving a long enough thread to sew back seam. Thread wool through remaining sts and pull up tightly and fasten. Using this wool sew seam from centre to bottom edge.

Pram Suit in Moss Stitch

Trousers

Right leg

Using larger needles cast on 20 sts and work 2 rows in g-st. Set pattern as follows:

1st row: *K2, P2, rep from * to end.

2nd row: *K2, P2, rep from * to end

3rd row: *P2, K2, rep from * to end

4th row: *P2, K2, rep from * to end

Cont in pattern inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 4th row until there are 26 sts and bringing extra sts into pattern. Cont without shaping for a further 5 rows thus ending with a ws row. ****You may wish to work extra rows here, especially for larger dolls in DK. Check your leg length and work further rows in pattern if required. End with a ws row and continue as follows****Break yarn. Leave sts on holder or safety pin.

Left leg

Using larger needles cast on 20 sts and work 2 rows in g-st. Set pattern as follows:

1st row: *K2, P2, rep from * to end.

2nd row: *K2, P2, rep from * to end

3rd row: *P2, K2, rep from * to end

4th row: *P2, K2, rep from * to end

Cont in pattern inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 4th row until there are 26 sts and bringing extra sts into pattern. Cont without shaping for a further 5 rows thus ending with a ws row. ****You may wish to work extra rows here, especially for larger dolls in DK. Check your leg length and work further rows in pattern if required. End with a ws row and continue as follows****Do not break yarn.

Body

Continuing in pattern on left leg, cast on 1 st and patt across 26 sts of left leg, turn and cast on 2sts,

Patt across 26 sts of right leg. Turn and cast on 1 st. (56 sts)

Work in patt for 17 rows. Change to smaller needles and work 4 rows of K1, P1 rib. Cast off in rib.

Making up

Join back seam of body from rib to crotch and cast on sts. Sew leg seams to bottom. Elasticate waist with shirring elastic.

Jacket

Back

Using larger needles cast on 28 sts. Work 4 rows in g-st.

Cont in patt as follows:

1st row: *K2, P2, rep from * to end.

2nd row: *K2, P2, rep from * to end

3rd row: *P2, K2, rep from * to end

4th row: *P2, K2, rep from * to end

Work a further 12 rows in patt.

Shape armholes

Keeping patt correct cast off 1 st at beg of next 2 rows. (26sts)

Work 14 rows in pattern.

Shape shoulders

Cast off 8 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Leave rem 10 sts on holder.

Left front

Using larger needles cast on 12 sts. Work 4 rows in g-st. Cont in patt as for back for 16 rows.

Shape armholes

Cast off 1 st at beg of next row. (11 sts). Work 8 rows in patt.

Shape neck

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next row. Dec 1 st at neck edge on next row (8sts). Work a further 5 rows in patt. Cast off rem 8sts.

Right front

Using larger needles cast on 12 sts. Work 4 rows in g-st. Cont in patt as for back for 15 rows.

Shape armholes

Cast off 1 st at beg of next row.(11 sts). Work 8 rows in patt.

Shape neck

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next row. Dec 1 st at neck edge on next row (8sts). Work a further 4 rows in patt. Cast off rem 8sts.

Sleeves

Cast on 16sts. Work 4 rows in g-st. Cont in patt as for back inc 1 st at each end of 1st and every foll 4th row until there are 24 sts, taking extra sts into patt. Work a further 5 rows. Cast off.

Neckband

Join shoulder seams. Using smaller needles pick up and K 8 sts up right front neck, K across 10sts of back and pick up and K 8 sts down left front neck. Work 3 rows in g-st. cast off.

Buttonband

Using smaller needles pick up and K 25 sts evenly along left front edge from top of neckband to bottom of front. Work 3 rows in g-st. Cast off

Buttonhole band

Using smaller needles pick up and K 25 sts evenly along right front edge bottom of front to top of neckband. Work 3 rows in g-st working button holes as follows on
2nd row: K3, yfwd, K2tog, K7, yfwd, K2tog, K7, K2tog, yfwd, K2.
Cast off.

Hat

Earflaps (x2)

Using smaller needles cast on 4sts and work 24 rows in K1, P1 rib.

Keeping rib patt correct inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row until there are 10sts. Work 1 row. Keep first earflap knitted on spare needle. Do not break yarn of 2nd flap and continue with hat as follows:

Main Hat

Using smaller needles and working from earflap cast on 5sts. K across sts of the earflap. Turn and cast on 10sts. Turn and K across other earflap. Turn and cast on 5 sts. (40sts) Change to larger needles and work 4 rows in g-st.

Cont in patt as follows: **1st row:**

*K2, P2, rep from * to end.

2nd row: *K2, P2, rep from * to end

3rd row: *P2, K2, rep from * to end

4th row: *P2, K2, rep from * to end

Work a further 6 rows in patt.

Decrease

1st row: K3, *K2tog, K4 rep from * to last st, K1 (34sts)

2nd and alt rows: P

3rd row: K3, *K2tog, K3, rep from * to last st, K1 (28sts)

5th row: K3, *K2tog, K2, rep from * to last st, K1 (22sts)

7th row: K3, *K2tog, K1, rep from * to last st, K1 (16sts)

8th row(alt): *P2tog, rep from * to end (8sts)

Cut yarn, leaving a long enough thread to sew back seam. Thread wool through remaining sts and pull up tightly and fasten. Using this wool sew seam from centre to bottom edge. If desired make small pompom or tassel and sew on

centre top of hat. Sew on motif or decorative button if desired to centre front.

Shoes

Using smaller needles cast on 15 sts. K2 rows. Work 2 rows in st-st starting with a K row.

Shape instep

Next row: K 9, turn

Next row: P 3 turn

Work 4 rows on these 3 sts. Break yarn.

Cont from 6 sts on rh needle and pick up and K 3 sts along side of instep, across 3 sts of instep, pick up and K 3 sts down other side of instep and across rem 6 sts. (21sts)
Next row: K8, inc in next st, K3, inc in next st, K to end. (23sts)

Work 4 rows in g-st.

Work 4 rows in st-st starting K.

Next row: *K first st on needle together with corresponding st of first row worked in st-st 4 rows below, cont from * to end. This tuck effect creates a 'sole' edge.

Shape sole

1st row: K 3, *K2tog, K2 rep from * to last 4 sts, K4 (19sts)

2nd row: K2tog, K5, K2tog, K1, K2tog, K5, K2tog (15sts)

Cast off.

Making up

Sew sole seam and back seam to complete shoe. Add decorative button or motif to front of shoe if desired.
