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Picot edged Lacy Matinee Set 16-22" dolls/newborn/0-3m baby

Materials

21-22" Doll/0-3m baby

100g double knitting yarn in Contrast Colour (US: light worsted) (pink)
200g double knitting yarn in Main Colour (US: light worsted) (white)
4mm needles (UK 8, US 6)
3 ¼ mm needles (UK10, US3)

19-20" Doll/newborn baby

100g double knitting yarn in Contrast Colour (US: light worsted) (pink)
200g double knitting yarn in Main Colour (US: light worsted) (white)

3 ¾ mm needles (UK 9, US 5)

3mm needles (UK11, no US equivalent use US3)

16-18" Doll/prem/small newborn baby

50g 4-ply yarn in Contrast Colour (US: sport) (pink)
100g 4-ply yarn in Main Colour (US: sport) (white)
3 ¼ mm needles (UK 10, US 3)
2 ¾ mm needles (UK12, US2)

All sizes

3 buttons
Elastic for waistband
Approx 4m narrow (7-8mm) ribbon
1m wide ribbon

Abbreviations

K: knit
P: purl
G-st: garter stitch
St-st: Stocking stitch
Dec: decrease
Inc: increase by knitting into front and back of stitch
Sl 1: slip next stitch
Pssso: Pass slipped stitch(es) over

Yfwd: Yarn forward
Yfon: yarn over needle
K2 tog: knit next 2sts together
P2tog: purl next 2sts together
Rs: right side
Ws: wrong side
Cont: continue
Sts: Stitches
1x1 rib: knit one, purl one rib

Tension (in st-st): please note that US equivalent yarns above are comparisons with UK yarns – if in doubt always check your tension!

4-ply: 28 stitches and 36 rows to 10 cm. (4 inches) on a 3 1/4 mm (US 3) needle.

Double knitting: 22 stitches and 30 rows to 10 cm. (4 inches) on a 4 mm (US 6) needle.

I have named the colours as pink and white when referring to the front cover pictures.

The pattern is written using the terms 'larger' and 'smaller' needles. If you are knitting for a 21-22" doll/0-3m baby use DK yarn and 4mm (larger) and 3¼ mm (smaller) needles as listed in materials. For the 19-20" doll/newborn baby use DK yarn and 3 ¾ mm needles (larger) and 3mm needles (smaller). For the 16-18" doll/ small newborn baby use 4-ply yarn and 3 ¼ mm (larger) and 2 ¾ mm (smaller) needles.

Matinee Coat

Back

Using larger needles and Contrast Colour cast on 26sts and K 1 row.
Work as follows in lacy edging pattern (number of stitches increases until row 12)

Row 1: Sl 1, K19, (yfon, K2tog)

twice, yfon, K2

Row 2: K8, P14, K5

Row 3: Sl 1, K6, (yfon, K2tog,

K1) four times, K2, (yfon, K2tog) twice, yfon, K2

Row 4: K9, P14, K5

Row 5: Sl 1, K21, (yfon, K2tog) twice, yfon, K2

Row 6: K

Row 7: Sl 1, K4, P14, K4, (yfon, K2tog) twice, yfon, K2

Row 8: K

Row 9: Sl 1, K4, P14, K5, (yfon, K2tog) twice, yfon, K2

Row 10: K

Row 11: Sl 1, K4, P14, K6, (yfon, K2tog) twice, yfon, K2

Row 12: Cast off 6sts, K25 (26sts)

Work a total of 144 rows in this pattern so 12 full sets of 12 rows worked. Cast off.

Using larger needles and main colour, pick up and K 74sts across

the straight edge of the lacy edging.

Cont as follows:

Row 1: K

Row 2: K1, *yfwd, K2tog; rep from * to last st, K1

Row 3: K

Cont in st-st for 5 rows.

Decrease

P2, *P2tog, P1; rep from * to end (50sts)

Shape armholes

Cast off 3sts at beginning of next two rows (44sts)

Shape raglans

Row 1: K1, Sl 1, K1, pssso, K to last 3sts, K2tog, K1

Row 2: P

Repeat rows 1 & 2 until 16sts remain, ending on row 2. Break yarn and leave sts on a holder.

Left Front

Using larger needles and contrast colour cast on 26sts and K 1 row. Work 72 rows of lacy edging pattern as for back. Cast off.

Using larger needles and main colour pick up and K 37sts along straight edge of lacy edging. Work as follows:

Row 1: K

Row 2: K1, *yfwd, K2tog; rep from * to end

Row 3: K

Cont in st-st for 5 rows.

Decrease

P1, *P2tog, P1; rep from * to end (25sts)**

Shape armhole

Cast off 3sts at beginning of next row (22sts)

P 1 row.

Shape raglan

Row 1: K1, Sl 1, K1, pssso, K to end

Row 2: P

Repeat rows 1 & 2 seven more times, and row 1 once more (13sts)

Shape neck

Cast off 3sts at beg of next row, P to end. Cont as follows:

Row 1: K1, Sl 1, K1, pssso, K to last 2sts, K2tog

Row 2: P2tog, P to end

Row 3: K1, Sl 1, K1, pssso, K to last 2sts, K2tog (5sts)

Row 4: P

Row 5: K1, Sl 1, K1, pssso, K to end

Repeat rows 4 & 5 twice more, and row 4 once more. K2tog and fasten off.

Right front

Work as left front to **
K 1 row.

Shape armhole

Cast off 3sts at beginning of next row (22sts)

Shape raglan

Row 1: K to last 3sts, K2tog, K1

Row 2: P

Repeat rows 1 & 2 seven more times (14sts)

Shape neck

Cast off 3sts at beg of next row, K to last 3sts, K2tog, K1. Cont as follows:

Row 1: P to last 2sts, P2tog

Row 2: K2tog, K to last 3sts, K2tog, K1

Row 3: P to last 2sts, P2tog (6sts)

Row 4: K to last 3sts, K2tog, K1

Row 5: P

Repeat rows 4 & 5 three times more. K2tog and fasten off.

Sleeves

Using smaller needles and main colour, cast on 30sts and work 6 rows in 1x1 rib.

Increase

K1, *inc in next st, K2; rep from * to last 2sts, inc in next st, K1 (40sts)

Change to larger needles and cont in st-st for 37 rows.

Shape armholes

Cast off 3sts at beg of next two rows (34sts)

Shape raglans

Row 1: K1, Sl 1, K1, pssso, K to last 3sts, K2tog, K1

Row 2: P

Repeat rows 1 & 2 until 6sts remain, ending on row 2. Leave rem 6sts on a safety pin.

Neckband

Sew raglan seams. Using smaller needles and main colour, pick up and K 12sts up rh neck, 6sts from sleeve, K 16sts from holder, 6sts from sleeve, pick up and K 12sts down neck (52sts)

Cont in 1x1 rib for 5 rows. Cast off in rib.

Button Band

Using smaller needle and main colour, pick up and K 26sts down the left front (white main colour part only)
Work 5 rows in 1x1 rib. Cast off in rib.

Buttonhole Band

Using smaller needle and main colour, pick up and K 26sts up the right front (white main colour part only)
Work 2 rows in 1x1 rib.

Buttonhole row (ws): Rib 2, (yfwd/yon, K2tog, rib 8) twice, yfwd/yon, K2tog, rib 2

Work 2 further rows in 1x1 rib.
Cast off in rib.

Making up

Sew sleeve and side seams. Sew on buttons. Thread ribbon through eyelets to tie in bow at front.

Trousers (main colour: make 2 pieces)

First Leg

Using larger needles cast on 32sts and work 4 rows in st-st

Next row: K1, *yfwd, K2tog, rep from * to last st, K1

Cont in st-st for 5 rows.

Join row: With right hand needle pick up the first stitch from the cast on edge and knit it together with the first stitch on the needle. Repeat this for the next stitch and all the way across the row until picot edge is complete.

K 1 row. Cont in st-st for 5 rows.

Next row: K

Next row: K1, *yfwd, K2tog, rep from * to last st, K1

Next row: K

Cont in st-st for 14 rows. Break yarn and leave sts on spare needle.

Second leg

Work as first leg but don't break yarn.

Main body

K across second leg, turn and cast on 10sts, turn and K across first leg (74sts)

P 1 row. Cont as follows:

Row 1: K31, Sl 1, K1, pssso, K8, K2tog, K31

Row 2, 4, 6 & 8: P

Row 3: K31, Sl 1, K1, pssso, K6, K2tog, K31

Row 5: K31, Sl 1, K1, pssso, K4, K2tog, K31

Row 7: K31, Sl 1, K1, pssso, K2, K2tog, K31

Row 9: K31, Sl 1, K1, pssso, K2tog, K31 (64sts)

Cont in st-st for 27 rows. Change to smaller needles and cont in 1x1 rib for 14 rows. Cast off in rib.

Making up

Sew side seams, crotch and leg seams. Placing a circle of elastic within the waistband, fold over and sew into place. Thread ribbon through eyelets.

Bonnet

Using larger needles and contrast colour cast on 26sts and K 1 row.

Cont in lacy edging pattern as for coat back for 84 rows. Cast off.

Using main colour and larger needles pick up and K 58sts across straight edge of lacy edging. K 1 row.

Cont in st-st for 6 rows.

Next row: K1, *yfwd, K2tog, rep from * to last st, K1

Cont in st-st for 5 rows.

Join row: With right hand needle pick up the first stitch 12 rows down (the first st-st row after the K row following the join) and knit it together with the first stitch on the needle. Repeat this for the next stitch and all the way across the row until picot ridge of bonnet is complete.

K 1 row.

Decrease

Row 1: K4, *K2tog, K4; rep from * to end

Row 2 and alt rows: P

Row 3: K4, *K2tog, K3; rep from * to end

Row 5: *K2tog, K2; rep from * to end

Row 7: *K2tog, K1; rep from * to end

Row 9: *K2tog; rep from * to end

Break yarn, thread through rem sts and fasten off tightly. Sew seam to picot ridge.

Neck edging

Using smaller needles and main colour, pick up and K 20sts from the **stocking stitch part of the lacy edging pattern to the centre and 20sts from the centre along the stocking stitch to the start of the garter stitch part of the lacy edging, so neck edging is not along the front frill edge of the bonnet.**

Work 5 rows in 1x1 rib. Cast off in rib. Sew ribbon to front of edging.

Boots

Using smaller needles and main colour cast on 28sts and work 3 rows in 1x1 rib. Change to larger needles.

Next row: K

Next row: K1, *yfwd, K2tog, rep from * to last st, K1

Next row: K

Cont in st-st for 4 rows.

Shape instep

K19, turn and P10, turn. Cont in st-st on these 10sts only for 10 rows. Break yarn.

Using main colour, working from 9sts on rh needle, pick up and K 8sts up instep, 10sts from needle, pick up and K 8sts down instep, K 9sts from needle.

Next row: P17, inc in next st, P8, inc in next st, P17 (46sts)

Cont as follows:

Change to contrast colour and K 2 rows. P 1 row.

Next row: K1, *K2tog, yfon, K1;
rep from * to end

Next row: P

Next row: K

Break contrast colour and cont in
main colour only. K 1 row. P 3
rows.

K 1 row. P 1 row.

Next row: K1, *yfwd, K2tog, rep
from * to last st, K1

Cont in st-st for 3 rows. Repeat
join row of picot ridge as for
bonnet **BUT** only 7 rows below.
K 1 row.

Shape sole

Row 1: K2tog, K19, K2tog twice,
K19, K2tog

Row 2: K

Row 3: K2tog, K17, K2tog twice
K17, K2tog

Row 4: K

Row 5: K2tog, K15, K2tog twice
K15, K2tog

Cast off. Sew sole and back seam.
Thread ribbon through eyelets to
tie. If desired thread ribbon
through eyelet holes of contrast
colour band for decoration.

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
