



## Snowflake Christmas Set 8-13" Dolls



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# Christmas Coat & Leggings set 8-13" dolls

## Materials

### 8-9" Doll

Approx 50g of 3 ply yarn in main colour, small amount in contrast colour (US: baby /fingering)  
Needles: One pair of 2 1/4 mm(UK 13)(US 1)

### 10-11" Doll

Approx 75g of 4 ply yarn in main colour, small amount in contrast colour (US: fingering/sport)  
Needles: One pair of 3 1/4 mm(UK 10)(US 3); one pair of 2 3/4 mm(UK 12)(US 2)

## Abbreviations

K: knit  
P: purl  
G-st: garter stitch  
St-st: Stocking stitch  
Dec: decrease  
Inc: increase by knitting (or purling if required) into front and back of stitch  
Sl 1: slip next stitch  
Sl2tog: Slip next 2sts together



### 12-13" Doll

Approx 100g of DK yarn in main colour, small amount in contrast colour (US: sport/worsted)  
Needles: One pair of 3 1/4 mm(UK10) (US 3); one pair of 4 mm(UK 8) (US 6)

## All 3 sizes

3 buttons  
Shirring elastic  
3m of ribbon

Pssso: Pass slipped stitch(es) over  
P2sso: Pass 2 slipped sts over  
Yfwd: Yarn forward  
K2 tog: knit next 2 stitches together  
Rs: right side  
Ws: wrong side  
Cont: continue  
Patt: pattern  
1x1 rib: K1, P1 rib

*\*\*The pattern is written using the terms 'larger' and 'smaller' needles. If you are knitting for a 12-13" doll use DK yarn and 4mm (larger) and 3 1/4 mm (smaller) needles as listed in materials. For the 10-11" doll use 4-ply yarn and 3 1/4 mm (larger) and 2 3/4 mm (smaller) needles. For the 8-9" doll use 3-ply yarn and 2 1/4 mm needles throughout (no larger or smaller)\*\**

**Tension (in st-st) please note that US equivalent yarns above are comparisons with UK yarns – if in doubt always check your tension!**

**3-ply:** 32 stitches and 40 rows to 10 cm. (4 inches) on a 3 1/4 mm (US 3) needle.

**4-ply:** 28 stitches and 36 rows to 10 cm. (4 inches) on a 3 1/4 mm (US 3)needle.

**Double knitting:** 22 stitches and 30 rows to 10 cm. (4 inches) on a 4 mm (US 6) needle.

## Coat (knitted in one piece to armholes)

Using larger needles and contrast colour  
cast on 125sts and P 1 row.

**Row 1:** K

**Row 2:** P

**Row 3:** K1, \*yfwd, K2tog; rep from \* to end

**Row 4:** P

**Row 5:** K

**Row 6:** P

Change to main colour and work 4 rows in st-st. Work 6 pattern rows as follows:

**Row 1:** K4, \*K2tog, yon, K1, yon, K2tog, K3; rep from \* to last st, K1

**Row 2:** P

**Row 3:** K5, \*yon, Sl2tog, K1, p2sso, yon, K5; rep from \* to end

**Row 4:** P

**Row 5:** As row 1

**Row 6:** P

K 1 row.

*Decrease*

\*P4, P2tog; rep from \* to last 5sts, P5 (105sts)

Change to contrast colour and work as follows:

**Next row:** K

**Next row:** K

**Next row:** K1, \*yfwd, K2tog; rep from \* to end

**Next row :** K

Change back to main colour and work 4 rows in st-st, working 1<sup>st</sup> row as follows:

**Row 1:** K5, \*K2tog, K29; rep from \* to last 7sts, K2tog, K5 (101sts)

Work 6 pattern rows as before.  
K 1 row.

### *Decrease*

\*P4, P2tog; rep from \* to last 5sts, P5 (85sts)

Change to contrast colour and work as follows:

**Next row:** K

**Next row:** K

**Next row:** K1, \*yfwd, K2tog; rep from \* to end

**Next row :** K

Change to main colour and work 5 rows in st-st

### *Decrease*

P3, \*P2tog, P1; rep from \* to last st, P1 (58sts)

### *Divide for armholes*

K12, cast off 4sts, K25 (26sts on needle), cast off 4sts, K to end.

Working on last set of 12sts cont as follows:

Work 8 rows in st-st

**Next row:** Cast off 2sts, P to end  
Decrease 1 st at neck edge on next 3 rows (7sts)

Cont in st-st for 5 rows. Cast off.

Rejoin yarn to centre 26 sts and work in st-st for 17 rows.

### *Shape shoulders*

Cast off 7sts, K11sts (12sts on needle), cast off rem 7sts. Leave 12sts on holder.

Rejoin yarn to last set of 12sts and work 9 rows in st-st.

**Next row:** Cast off 2sts, K to end  
Decrease 1 st at neck edge on next 3 rows (7sts)

Cont in st-st for 4 rows. Cast off.

### Sleeves

Using larger needles and contrast colour cast on 20sts and P 1 row. Cont as follows:

**Row 1:** K

**Row 2:** P

**Row 3:** K1, \*yfwd, K2tog; rep from \* to last st, K1

**Row 4:** P

**Row 5:** K

**Row 6:** P

**Row 7:** Inc in every st except last (39sts)

**Row 8:** K

**Row 9:** K1, \*yfwd, K2tog; rep from \* to end

**Row 10:** K

Change to main colour and work 2 rows in st-st. Work pattern rows as follows:

**Row 1:** K17, K2tog, yon, K1, yon, K2tog, K17

**Row 2:** P

**Row 3:** K18, yon, Sl2tog, K1, p2sso, yon, K18

**Row 4:** P

**Row 5:** As row 1

**Row 6:** P

**Row 7:** K

**Row 8:** P

Repeat rows 1-8 twice more.

Cont in st-st for 2 rows. Cast off.

### Hood

Join shoulder seams. Sew sleeve seams. Pin sleeves in place and sew seams. Using larger needles and main colour, pick up and K 9sts up rh neck, K 12sts from holder, pick up and K 9sts down neck.

**Next row:** P9, inc in next 12sts, P9 (42sts)

Cont in st-st for 34 rows. Cast off. Fold hood in half and join seam.

### Band and Hood edging

Using contrast colour and smaller needles pick up and K 40sts up rh front, pick up and K 22sts up hood to top seam of hood, 22sts from top seam to hood end, pick up and K 40sts down left hand front.

**Next row:** K40, P44, K40

**Next row:** K24, (yfwd, K2tog,

K4) twice, yfwd, K2tog, K to end

**Next row:** K40, P44, K40

**Next row:** Cast off 40sts, (yfwd, K2tog) 21 times, K1, cast off rem 40sts.

Rejoin yarn to centre sts and P 1 row. K1 row, P 1 row. Cast off. Fold over picot edge and sew in place.

### Making up

Fold over bottom picot edge and sew in place. Sew buttons on button band. Thread ribbon through sleeve eyelets to tie. Thread ribbon through eyelet holes in main coat and sew in place at each end.

### **Leggings**

#### Right leg

##### Foot

Using larger needles and main colour cast on 19sts. (*Work increase sts on purl rows purlways*)

**1<sup>st</sup> row:** K

**2<sup>nd</sup> row:** P4, inc in next st, P3, inc in next st, P4, inc in next st, P2, inc in next st, P2 (23sts)

**3<sup>rd</sup> row:** K

**4<sup>th</sup> row:** P5, inc in next st, P3, inc in next st, P6, inc in next st, P2, inc in next st, P3 (27sts)

**5<sup>th</sup> row:** K

**6<sup>th</sup> row:** P6, inc in next st, P3, inc in next st, P16 (29sts)

#### Instep

**1<sup>st</sup> row:** K13, K2togtbl, turn.

**2<sup>nd</sup> row:** P5, P2tog, turn

**3<sup>rd</sup> row:** K5, K2togtbl, turn

Repeat 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> rows once more, then 2<sup>nd</sup> row once more (23sts)

**Next row:** K across all sts on lh needle

**Next row:** P across all sts

**Next 2 rows:** K

**Next row:** K1, \*yfwd, K2tog; rep from \* to end

**Next row:** K

### Increase

\*K1, inc in next 2sts; rep from \* to last 2sts, K2 ( 37sts)  
Cont in st-st for 23 rows. Break yarn and leave sts on spare needle.

### Left leg

#### Foot

Using larger needles cast on 19sts.

**1<sup>st</sup> row:** K

**2<sup>nd</sup> row:** P2, inc in next st, P2, inc in next st, P4, inc in next st, P3, inc in next st, P4 (23sts)

**3<sup>rd</sup> row:** K

**4<sup>th</sup> row:** P3, inc in next st, P2, inc in next st, P6, inc in next st, P3, inc in next st, P5 (27sts)

**5<sup>th</sup> row:** K

**6<sup>th</sup> row:** P16, inc in next st, P3, inc in next st, P6 (29sts)

### Instep

**1<sup>st</sup> row:** K20, K2togtbl, turn.

**2<sup>nd</sup> row:** P5, P2tog, turn

**3<sup>rd</sup> row:** K5, K2togtbl, turn

Repeat 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> rows once more, then 2<sup>nd</sup> row once more (23sts)

**Next row:** K across all sts on lh needle.

**Next row:** P across all sts

**Next 2 rows:** K

**Next row:** K1, \*yfwd, K2tog; rep from \* to end

**Next row:** K

#### Increase

\*K1, inc in next 2sts; rep from \* to last 2sts, K2 ( 37sts)

Cont in st-st for 23 rows. DO NOT break yarn.

### Body

*Place a marker at beg and end of this row.* Cont on left leg, K across

37 sts of left leg, K across 37 sts of right leg. (74sts)

Work in st-st for 23 rows.

Change to smaller needles and work 4 rows of K1, P1 rib. Cast off in rib.

### Making up

Join back seam of body from rib to crotch (row with markers). Sew leg seams to bottom. Making sure that foot is correctly aligned (folded flat so shaping is ‘foot-shaped’, join bottom foot seam. Thread shirring elastic under raised knit rows of inside rib and fasten off to desired length. Thread ribbon through eyelets of ankle to tie.
